WAYS TO PLAY A FASTER ROUND

1. AVOID " 1 CLUB " BAG SWAP

Always pull a club white replacing another...

Example: keep putter in your hands for cart ride to next tee, place in bag and take out driver.

2. KICK "HONORS" TO THE CURB

Play "ready golf" If you're ready to hit either from tee box or fairway then hit. There are "no turns "

3. SEE IT, READ IT, HOLE IT

While others are putting, read your putt and be ready when you're up.

4. ALWAYS BE PREPARED

Start round with tees, markers, ball & repair tool. Write down scores at next tee box

5. CART SMART

Drop off your partner & drive to your ball or vise versa

6. WATCH YOUR PARTNERS

When someone hits errant shot, watch closely to pin point location. NO LONGER THAN 3 MINUTES TO SEARCH FOR BALL.

7 DITCH YOUR HEADCOVERS

Taking off and putting back every time is a serious time suck.

8. FORWARD TEES

Those playing forward tees should ride together.

Forward players might tee off first if they cant reach group in fairway.

9. CART PATH ONLY

Take several clubs out to your ball, don't walk back and forth to cart.

WHY DO I SEE PLAYERS STANDING IN FAIRWAY WAITING TO HIT TOWARDS GREEN ON NEXT SHOT?

IF YOU'RE 180 YARDS OUT AND YOU CAN'T HIT IT 180 YARDS WHY ARE YOU WAITING & HOLDING UP OTHER GROUPS.??? EVERYDAY OCCURANCE.

IF EACH OF US CAN PLAY EACH HOLE JUST 30 SECONDS FASTER THAT'S 9 MINUTES PER ROUND FASTER

1 MINUTE FASTER IS 18 MINUTES...

SOME OF YOU MAY BE FAST PLAYERS BUT BEING SLOWED DOWN BY A MEMBER OF YOUR GROUP WHO IS A LITTLE SLOW.... PUSH THEM

IT'S YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO PUSH THEM
