

COVID RULES – PINS/BUNKERS – September 14, 2020

As of June 23rd, Covid rules were put in play for all Metro Senior Weekly events and Metro Senior Special Events. We will follow these rules for the September 14 Last Chance best ball tournament. All players should bring a mask to be worn while checking in, while gathering for the shotgun start, and while picking up your lunch. Maintain social distance on the putting green, driving range, on the course, and during lunch.

Carts – Single carts are not an option. We will ride two per cart. There are no dividers. You may bring a portable divider, but the cart must not be damaged or altered in any way to accommodate the divider.

Foam/Sponge/Anything in the hole, but ABOVE the level of the hole - a ball striking this substance will be considered as having been made.

Foam/Sponge BELOW level of the hole - Consider the putt or chip as being made if:

- the ball comes to rest physically IN the hole
- the ball goes into the hole, strikes the foam/sponge and bounces out
- the ball is rolling and strikes the pin

Striking the pin - in cups that are raised or have foam in them, if the ball is **ROLLING** on the green and strikes the pin, regardless of whether it is a chip or a putt, it counts as having gone in. If the ball is **NOT ROLLING** (like it's bouncing), play it as it lies

Flag Stick – Do Not remove or touch the flag stick. This removes a common contact point.

Hole-in-One - the ball **MUST** end up physically in the hole.

Bunkers - We will NOT play sand traps. Do not play the ball in the sand. Drop your ball **WITHOUT PENALTY** behind the trap (not on the side) and play from there. This removes the rake as a common contact point. There is no need to touch a rake.

Follow the guidelines, Have fun, Watch your pace of play.
